The highest grown arabica we contract, wet hulled in Toraja at 1,400 to 1,900 m, in grades 1 to 6.

LOT OVERVIEW

Smallholder arabica from the Toraja mountains of South Sulawesi, shade dried and wet hulled, then sorted harder than any other coffee we handle. Dense beans, dark chocolate and warm spice in the cup, with the body of a wet hulled coffee and a cleaner finish. Organic certified, with Grade 1 cupping 85 to 87 points and the lower grades quoted for blend volume.

Figures are typical for the current crop and are confirmed lot by lot on the contract. The signed grading sheet and cupping score travel with every shipment.

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
