Gayo Sumatra Arabica Green Coffee Beans

Wet hulled arabica from the Gayo and Lintong highlands, offered from Grade 1 through Grade 6 on the same coffee.

- Arabica coffee
- Sumatra



- Grade 1 to 6 quoted on one coffee, defect counted per 300 g
 - Grade 1 cups 84 to 86 points, scored by two Q Graders before the offer
- Wet hulled at 30 to 50% moisture, the classic giling basah method
 - 60 kg jute with GrainPro liner, loaded with desiccant and a moisture card

LOT OVERVIEW

Smallholder arabica from northern Sumatra, pulped the day it is picked and wet hulled at 30 to 50% moisture (giling basah). Same growing areas and mills at every grade; defect count sets the grade from 1 to 6.

Figures are typical for the current crop and are confirmed lot by lot on the contract. The signed grading sheet and cupping score travel with every shipment.

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
